### Hull Design Company support for the Hull People's Memorial

This is a fantastic opportunity to education the children, adults and visitors to the city about Hull's wartime stories on, or near, the sites where the bombs actually fell.”

Ever the opportunist, Alan continues;

“What we need now are even more local companies to follow the lead of *designs* Operations Director, Gary Vieten. While serving in the Armed Forces I very quickly learned that it is always better to scrounge than spend. There must be a lot of willing companies out there who could lend a hand – and our shopping list is endless! We would particularly love to here from anyone with an empty property in the city centre where we can set up an exhibition space and small shop for the next 2½ to 3 years. We need exhibition stands for our displays, ‘stuff’ to sell in our shop and are we are more than happy to accept cash donations too! I would ‘Ask Aneka’ but I seem to have mislaid her telephone number just now. However, anything she can do, Hull can do better. The people have a real passion and pride in their city.”

The Hull Remembers team, who are all volunteers, are raising the funds for their project through public subscription and are very keen that all public monies go directly into the memorial fund and not be spent on overheads. Monetary donations from local companies will be paid into the memorial fund with all ‘donations in kind’ helping to pay project running costs.
